I'm writing this e-mail to inform you that Metropol is struggling. We are taking care of 700+ residents, lots of children (approximate one to four ratio children to adults) and infants (and a fair few neonates). To make this situation safe I need my colleagues who set up the processes in the beginning: [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]. We have a challenging task, taking care of 150 folks each. Please let the veterans do their work. I'm always happy and enthusiastic about orienting new nurses but there is so much work to do. We are starting to miss things that thankfully could be rectified.

I'm doing a lot of extra work by living in the hotel where I work. I understand this is my choice. This is why my timesheets reflect the overtime I do. I have been under reporting these hours.

We have been thrown another challenge tonight at 23:00. Crown decrees we move rooms (all of DHHS- AOs, PCAs, De Nata, etc.), they have generously given us TONIGHT to achieve this. Can we please have an extra PCA. I have grave fears that care will be severely interrupted as do the nightshift tonight. It is not safe. The management at crown have refused giving us 2 night shifts to do it. This is not asking much from crown. I think it will be easier to just do it rather than fight it. If there is a suicidal ideation like there was one last night we will be swamped.

Thanks for your support and I really appreciate this work.
